

Token Decimals

Guidelines:

Token decimals is a list of tokens addresses and decimal places. It's purpose is to provide the number of decimal places used by tokens that throw an error if the 'decimals' function of its contract is called.

Examples of rejection reasons are given in italic.

Reject a submission if:

- > The address does not belong to a token in the same chain of this list.
- > There is an accepted item for this address (i.e. no duplicates are allowed).
- > The number of decimal places is wrong.

Accept all submissions otherwise.
